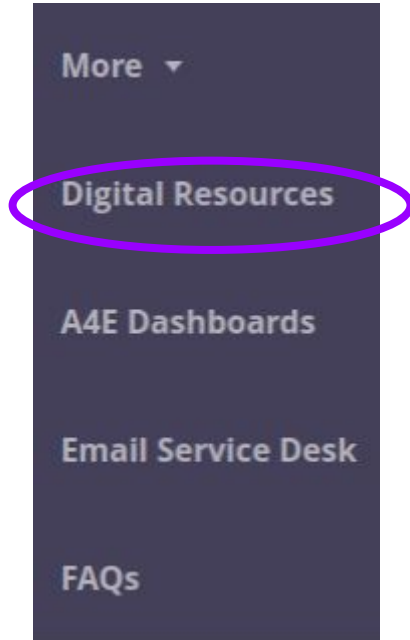
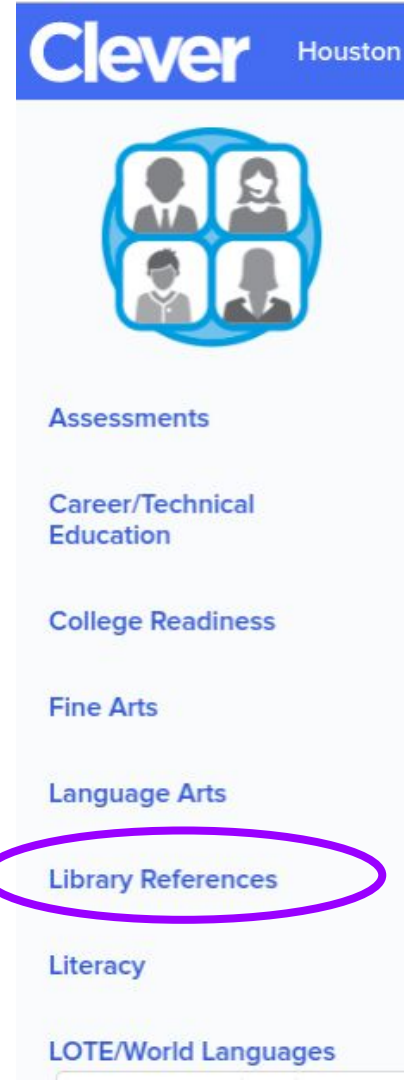


How to use Learn360

First, you need to get to Clever, through Digital Resources on the HUB.



Then, you need to find Library References.



Once you are in Library References, find Learn360.

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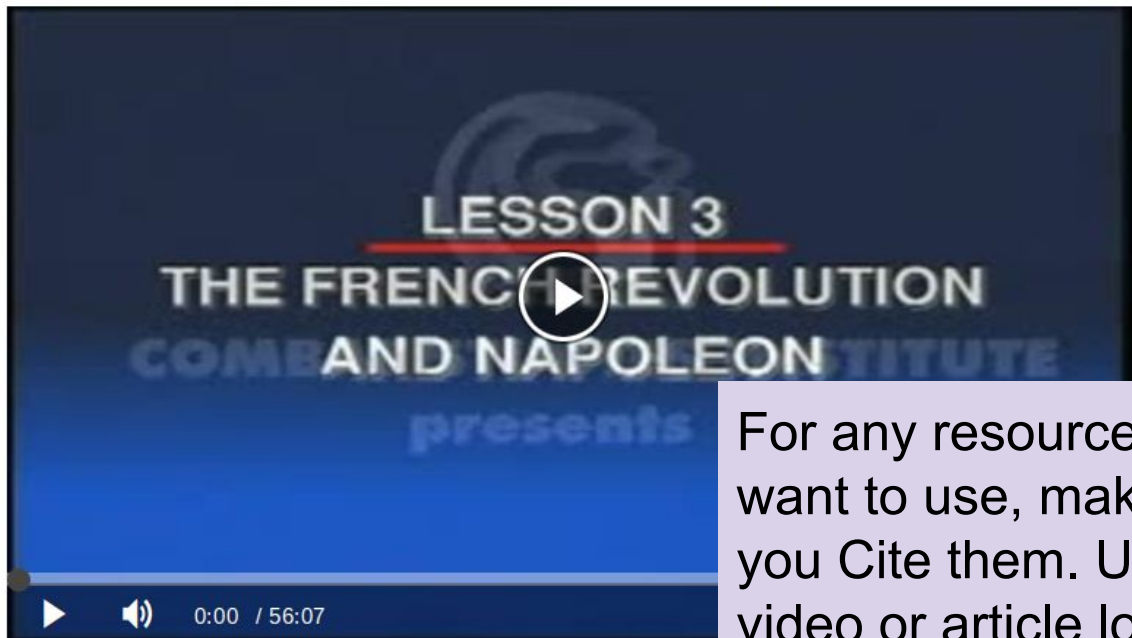
