

Step 3 - Research

- **Discover the facts!**
- **Use a lot of resources**
 - **Make sure they are GOOD resources**
 - **Resources from Clever are GOOD**
 - **Wikipedia is not a good resource!**
- **Cite your sources!** (*more on this later)
- **Record your notes**

Step 3 - Research

- Each different resource (things like websites, books, newspaper articles, encyclopedias, maps, and photographs) you use will have its own number.
- Record the required information for your bibliography.
 - A bibliography is a list of all of the sources you used.
- Make sure that you give credit to each source!
 - Plagiarism is a serious issue.
 - How would you feel if someone took credit for your work?

Step 3 - Research

- **Note**facts are short and true pieces of information that help answer the questions on your topic.
- **Note**facts should be
 - In your own words (don't copy exactly what you see on the page)
 - Short **BUT** complete enough to make sense
 - Connected to the questions you came up with

Steps of Research:

Login to Clever

- Choose an app to use (World Book, BrainPop, TexQuest, MyOn, Discovery Education)

Search for your topic

- When you find an article you like **write down**: Where it came from, Who wrote it, When they wrote it, What the title is
 - Give that information a number (1 for your first resource and so on)
- Write down the answers you find to your questions (These are your Notefacts!).
 - Be sure to write them in your own words! Don't copy directly from the article.

- Once you've read the entire article, and answered as many questions as possible, go back to Clever and use a new app!

Here are the resources to focus on in Clever. In our recorded meeting I'll show you one, and in the next recorded meeting I'll go into some of the others, but these will be the best for research.
